Why read so much to young children?

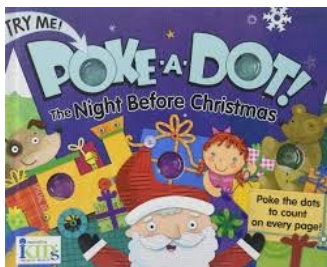
Increase vocabulary, social/emotional connection with others, benefits for behavior and attention, as well as concept development are just a few reasons to encourage reading daily.
