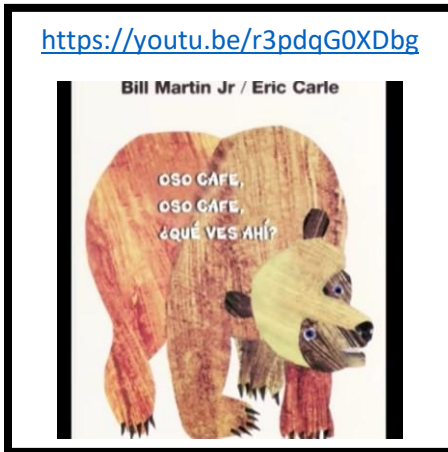




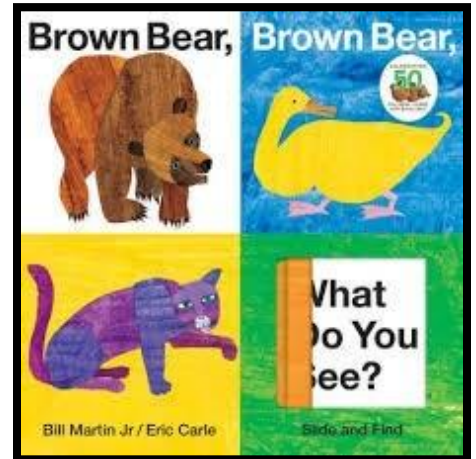

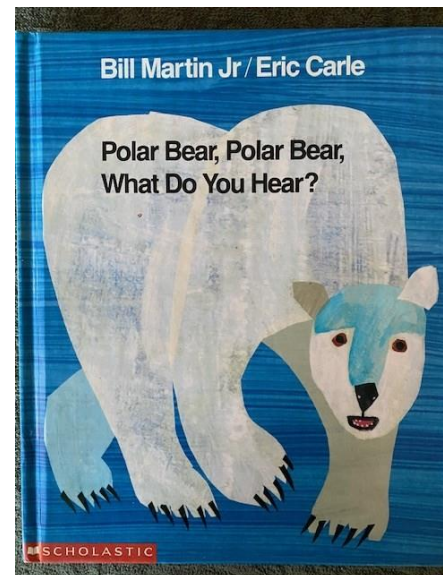

Why is this a great book for toddlers?

Repeating the phrase on each page builds excitement and anticipation, setting the stage for imitation of language. It provides opportunities to practice color words, wherever your child is on the road to mastery of colors. The story features familiar animals for children to identify with their own animal toys and practice animal sounds. The pattern of question/answer models inflection, the cadence of the text encourages children to join in.

Tips for reading to toddlers

- It's great to adapt the story to your child's attention span.
 - You can skip pages and not read all the words.
 - Talk about a few key things in the middle and the end; that is a successful book reading.
- Think about ways to interact with the book beyond the pages.
 - Make sounds for animals or vehicles. Use exclamations!
 - Be animated and silly.
- It is okay to put the book down and use your hands or find things around the house to act out themes in a book.
