



Fake Snow (Sensory play)

Materials needed:

- Baking Soda (1/4 cup)
- Cornstarch (1/4 cup)
- Water
- A large glass bowl for mixing
- Large tray or bin to play in the snow
- Ziplock baggie to mix and keep snow

Directions:

You can also mix your fake snow in a bowl and transfer it to a tray afterward.

1. Start by pouring equal amounts of cornstarch and baking soda onto the tray or into a bowl. The recipe calls for a 1:1 ratio of baking soda to cornstarch. You can also measure if that works best for you.
2. Mix the baking soda and cornstarch with your fingers.
3. Next, you want to add just enough water so that you can form a ball when you squeeze some of the mixture in your hands.
4. Gently loosen any clumps until your fake snow looks just like real snow.

FAKE SNOW TIP: Make sure to add the water very slowly. And if you end up with a mixture that's too runny, simply add a bit more of the baking soda and cornstarch mixture
