Learning Themes:

Chicks, Eggs, Pretend (Fantasy) Play, Castles/Pirates and Ships

Holiday: Easter

Learning Concepts:

Shapes, colors, prepositions (in/on, under/over, behind/front) & cause/effect

These are not date specific, so you can pick whatever works for your family. You may want to try them all or pick a few favorites to do more than once. The idea is to have fun.

- 1. Easter egg or toy hunt in your house
- 2. Finger Play: Five Little Bunnies
- 3. Dress Up with Older Sibling or Adult clothes
- 4. Sensory Play: Beans, Big Plastic Coins, Bead Necklaces, Rings, Wands, Treasure Box, Little People, Jewels
- 5. Go to a Park and Pretend the Play Structure is a Pirate Ship
- 6. Sing "Row Row Row Your Boat"
- 7. Set up 10 Water Bottles Filled with Blue Water and Bowl them Over with a Ball
- 8. Snack: Make a Trail Mix of 4 different foods: Call it Treasure Mix
- 9. Make a Toilet Paper or Paper Towel Telescope
- 10. Read a book about a pirate or a princess
- 11. Go for a Walk
- 12. Pretend to be a Dragon
- 13. Make a Pirate Ship out of Laundry Basket or Box (Add a Sail)
- 14. Make and Decorate a Pirate Hat or Crown
- 15. Go on a Scavenger Hunt: Find Things insider or outside (See examples)
- 16. Finger Play Five Little Pirates
- 17. Play I Spy with your telescope: Examples: I see a tree, I see you, Can you find a rock, Do you see a bird?
- 18. Snack: Pirate Ship: Cut an apple or orange into wedges, Poke a toothpick in it, put a piece of cheese on the toothpick for a sail
- 19. Make a balance beam: 2 Logs and a board or just a piece of tape on the floor. Walk the line and jump off
- 20. Put coins or toys in a slotted container (piggy bank, treasure box)
- 21. Make a necklace: String cereal, cut up straws, noodles, paper cut-outs (flowers, stars, shapes)
- 22. Bury some treasure in your yard
- 23. Sensory: Make a lagoon: Rocks, sea creatures, ducks, shells, boats, water
- 24. Listen to music: Peter Pan, A Pirates life for me, Princess Songs, Pirate songs
- 25. Snack: Pirate Telescope: Flour tortilla cream cheese roll-up
- 26. Princess or Pirate What do you see (To Brown Bear Brown Bear)
- 27. Song: Going on a Dragon Hunt
- 28. Color outside with sidewalk chalk
- 29. Read one of your favorite childhood books or fairy tale books with your family.
- 30. Make a ball pit lagoon; Put balls in a pool, box, or laundry basket
