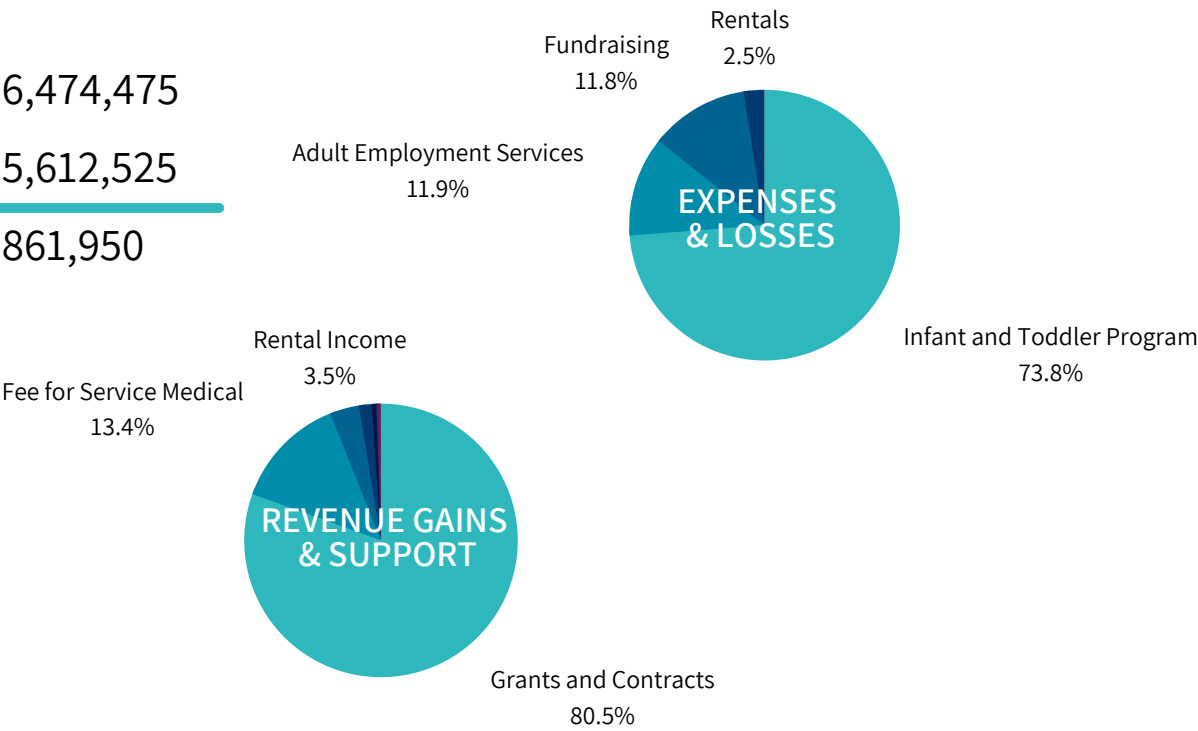
Early Intervention is the key to achieving greater developmental gains for children who are diagnosed with a disability or who have a developmental concern at birth or very early childhood.
