

# Books to Read to Toddlers

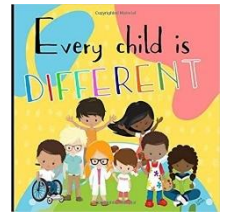


Why read so much to young children?

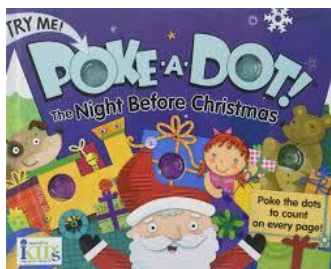
Increased vocabulary, social/emotional connection with others, benefits for behavior and attention, and concept development are just a few reasons to encourage reading daily.
