Use this card with your child to encourage cognitive and language development during outings.

How to use:

- Show your child the pictures, read the label, point to, or touch each picture.
- Encourage your child to touch each picture or attempt to say the words.
- Point things out to your child; children learn through repetition, so use simple language like "I see an apple" or "red apple," depending on your child's skill level.
- Use songs to engage your child, like "Wheels on the Bus."
- If you have other children that go to school, use this card when getting them ready in the morning to have your little one help them get off to school.
- Let your child walk their siblings to school or the bus stop to be involved socially and learn what to expect for the day they are ready for school.

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
