Try out some of these fun activities to keep your little ones busy and having fun!**



- Have your child help you make hot cocoa or bake cookies, they can help pour and stir!
- This is a great opportunity to introduce new seasonal vocabulary to your child like: snow, cold, snowman, hot, cocoa, cookies, yum, etc.
- "The Floor is Lava" is a popular game among children, there is a song and video on Youtube you can play, children follow the direction (dance, jump, run) and when they say "the floor is lava" you get up off the floor onto a chair, couch, pillow, etc. then you get down and repeat!
